To facilitate this, Academic Bank of Credits (ABC) is developed by the Central Government, and looked after by "The DigiLocker" website.

Students must register on the website "<https://www.nad.Digilocker.gov.in>", and create their ABC ID, and fetch their testimonials from their respective Board/Universities in their DigiLocker. ABC ID is mandatory and required for submission at the time of admission/exam.
