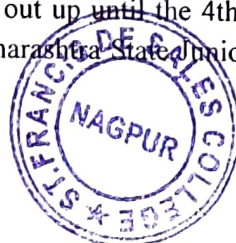
Report Department of Physical Education (Senior College)
