

TEACHING LEARNING PROCESS

Faculty members prepare and submit a teaching plan for theory and practical classes for the respective semester in accordance with the syllabus prescribed by the University. This enables the faculty to complete their syllabi in a timely manner and engage extra classes if required.

Co-curricular activities of the Department are reflected in the calendar. Effective implementation of the plan is monitored periodically by HODs and Principal. The contents of the curriculum are delivered systematically by faculty members through classroom teaching, laboratory demonstration, projects, assignments, seminars, guest lectures, workshops, field visits, etc. Importance is given to the use of ICT tools like PPTs, animations, videos, e-books, etc.
